### **Bagatelle**

Hidden behind the dual patio entrance to STK on La Cienega, this French Mediterranean café meets social gathering watering hole (they have a DJ and a bar that people have been known to dance on), is a fantastic idea for celebrating Bastille Day this year. They are offering a special brunch on Sunday, which includes their famous truffle [roasted chicken](#), but go anytime for oysters, steak tartare or fruits de mer with a glass of Rosé or Champagne when you want to toast France. Mixologist Zack Patterson uses Absinthe and Champagne in creative cocktails, so be sure to try 'Death in the Afternoon' (a favorite of Ernest Hemingway back in the day), before or after your meal. Global locations include Las Vegas, New York, Miami, Sao Palo and St. Barts.
