# Spots to sip and shout on Super Bowl Sunday

But Angelenos don't have to have a stake in either team game to enjoy football fun at these spots in the South Bay celebrating the end of the NFL season:

Barney's Beanery, of Hollywood fame, recently opened on the Redondo Beach pier next to El Torito at 100 Fisherman's Wharf. It's got an amazing view of the beach below, 12 TV-watching stations (with a total of 50 TVs throughout the eatery), almost 200 different beers to choose from and several different kinds of rib-sticking chili in their 700-item menu of American comfort food.
